The next two items are ones you will want to make sure are available before you start racking your beer into a bottling bucket.

- Sanitizer (I like Star San)
- Priming Sugar (to make priming solution) or carbonation tabs
- Empty Bottles (Make sure you have enough for what you plan to bottle)
 - o <u>12 Ounce Brown Bottles</u> Standard-sized beer bottles
 - o <u>22 Ounce Amber Bottles</u> Great option to bottle lots of beer quickly
- Bottle Caps (Make sure you have enough caps and that they fit your bottles)

In addition to the items listed above, on bottling day you will need the items below:

- Pot to boil/sanitize your priming solution (unless using carbonation tabs)
- Bottling bucket
- Siphon/Racking Cane and hoses
- Bottle Capper
 - o A wing capper is usually included with your equipment kit
 - o I upgraded to a bench capper because I kept braking the necks of bottles.
- Bottling wand (optional) no need to turn the spigot on and off.

Process

- 1. Clean bottles (can be done day before)
- 2. Sanitize & cover bottling bucket
- 3. Sanitize racking can and hoses
- 4. Make priming solution
- 5. Add priming solution to bottling bucket
- 6. Rack beer into bottling bucket
- 7. Sanitize bottles
- 8. Fill & cap bottles
- 9. Wipe residue off bottles
- 10. Place bottles in warm location to carbonate
